



## **National Meteorological Olympiad**

India Meteorological Department (IMD) is celebrating its 150th anniversary on January 15, 2025. To commemorate this historic milestone, IMD has planned year-long activities starting January 15, 2024, culminating in a grand Foundation Day celebration at Bharat Mandapam, New Delhi, in the presence of distinguished dignitaries.

As part of the celebrations, IMD will organize a National Meteorological Olympiad (Met-Olympiad) to promote interest and awareness about weather and climate sciences among students. The Olympiad will target students from classes 8th, 9th, and 11th, conducted at state and national levels.

### **About the Olympiad**

The Olympiad will be conducted in two stages:

1. State Level: An online test for registered participants.
2. National Level: A contest and workshop for state-level winners in New Delhi.

The Olympiad features a 1-hour online examination with 60 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) based on meteorology and related sciences. Study materials, syllabus, and sample questions are available on the official portal (<https://mausam.imd.gov.in/met-oly/>).

### **Eligibility and Registration**

- Open to students from classes 8, 9, and 11.
- Registration is online at <https://mausam.imd.gov.in/met-oly/>
- The Olympiad will be conducted in English only.
- This is a free program, and there are no fees for the Met-Olympiad.

Participants must ensure their devices (computer, laptop, tablet, or mobile) and internet connectivity are compatible with the online test platform. Organizers are not liable for technical issues during the exam.

### **Awards**

#### **State-Level Prizes**

For each class (8, 9, 11):

- 1st Prize: ₹5000
- 2nd Prize: ₹3000
- 3rd Prize: ₹2000

Top three state-level winners from each class will be invited to New Delhi for:

- ⑩ One-day workshop on January 14, 2025.
- ⑩ Participation in IMD's 150th Foundation Day Celebration on January 15, 2025.
- ❖ All travel (via shortest route in 3AC by train) and lodging expenses for the winners and one accompanying teacher or guardian will be borne by IMD.

### **National-Level Prizes**

State-level top two winners from each class will compete at the national level. National winners will receive:

- 1st Place: ₹25,000
- 2nd Place: ₹15,000
- 3rd Place: ₹10,000

Additionally, certificates of participation (soft copies) will be awarded to all students who will complete the Olympiad.

- Registration Opens: December 1, 2024
- Registration Closes: December 10, 2024
- State-Level Exam: December 14–15, 2024
- Declaration of State-Level Results: December 17, 2024
- National-Level Camp & Contest: January 14, 2025
- IMD's Foundation Day Celebration and distribution of awards: January 15, 2025

This Olympiad is a fantastic opportunity for young minds to delve into the field of meteorology and earn prestigious rewards!

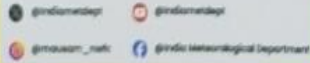
