Parents who would like their wards to participate in this competition, should give the names of their wards to the class teacher by 10th Oct.2. The Participants will come dressed up from home or dress up in the school as per the theme.3. Parent can accompany the child if required.4. Students don't have to speak anything on the stage. They have to present themselves on the stage for a few seconds till the judges do their judging. Background music will be played during that time.5. Each participant will be given a Contestant Number slip which the students have to pin up on their chest during the contest.6. Face mask can be allowed if required as per the character.7. The decision of the Judges will be final. Judgment criteria : As per Theme, Confidence, Costume, Presentation

Students have to bring their own materials including Card Sheet required for the competition.6. All students can participate. Judgment criteria : Creativity, Presentation, Neatness, Message of greetings, Colour combination.

OCT.17,2022	RANGOLI MAKING COMPETITION Theme Deepawali	VI - VIII	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. It is a class wise competition. 2. Each class will make one Rangoli in front of their class room on the varanda with colourful flowers or dry colourful Rangoli powders, which can be easily erased later. 3. The Teacher can select a few students (8 to 10 students) to make the Rangoli. 4. The size of Rangoli should be 3'x3' only. 5. Time Limit : 1 hour 6. Criteria for Judging: Related to Theme, Colour combination & Presentation.
OCT.17,2022	PAPER CRACKERS MAKING COMPETITION	IX - XII	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Each section of each class can have maximum 3 groups of students consisting of 5 students in each group. 2. Interested students can give their names to the class teacher by 12th Oct. 3. Students are to make Paper crackers with News Papers, colour papers, card papers, paper sticks etc. 4. Students can make as many crackers as possible and label them. 5. Three groups from each class (not section) will be awarded 1st, 2nd & 3rd position. 6. Criteria for Judging: Creativity, Resemblance to real crackers, Number of Crackers & Presentation.

There will be a selection process on 13th Oct. and two students from each section will be selected. 4. The Time Limit for the speech will be 30 seconds to 45 seconds. 5. Criteria for Judging: Related to Theme, Memory, Articulation & Presentation.

All materials for the competition have to be brought by the participants. 7. Time Limit: 1 hour 8. Criteria: Relevant to Theme, Creativity & Presentation

It is a class activity. 8. Selection and practice will be done by class teacher. Music Teachers can help out. <p>Judgment criteria: Melody, Expressions, Rhythm, Dress Code, Harmonization</p>

Duration of dance will be 4-5 minutes only. 5. Proper props & costumes should be used 6. Language: Any Indian language. <p>Judgment criteria : Presentation , co-ordination, expressions, costume & props</p>

Story should be original. 6.Proper props should be used. <p>Judgment criteria : Presentation, Related to Theme, costume, clarity of dialogue, acting skills.</p>
